The offers are then evaluated by the artist at the end of the show and will be decide whether or not it is worth trading for. The exhibition includes Tim Barber, Terrance Koh, Bruce High Quality, and others. Art Barter opens today from noon till 6pm and will run until 12th of December at NP Contemporary Art Centre, 131 Chrystie Street.
